Our 2021 budget mirrors our 2020 budget with very few significant changes:

- -The "Miscellaneous" revenue line item is decreased by 71.4% in 2021. This miscellaneous revenue is generated from the sale of our mailing list. We have seen a major decline in interest of our mailing list in the past few years, therefore we are anticipating a decrease in miscellaneous revenue 2021.
- -The "Interest Earned" has an increase of 42.9% because increasing cash flow and interest rates in our bank accounts and CD's.
- The "Fringe Benefits" is decreased by 28.6% because we only have one employee charged to our TDF Fund.
- The payments on long term debt for principal and interest have increased because we received a new loan in the amount of \$400,000 for a 30 year period beginning in July 2020.
- The unrestricted net position utilized has increased because if we do not receive the anticipated revenues based on taxes we will still need to make our contractual payments using monies from the reserve.

The Tourism Authority's overall revenues are sustained through the tourism economy of the Wildwoods. Over the last 6 years we have seen 4% growth, not including the 2020 pandemic year. We believe that 2021 will be a strong year for tourism.

In 2021 we are estimating our tax revenues conservatively. If 2021 does not follow years 2018 and 2019 which were our best years, we will have the Unrestricted Net Position moneys to use.
