Our 2024 budget mirror our 2023 budget with very few significant changes:

The 2% Tourism Tax has increased by 11.2% as we have seen tax collctions continue to increase in recent years and we believe this trend will continue for 2024. The Interest Earned has increased by 19.3% in anticipation of earnning a higher return as interest rates continue to climb and we believe this trend will continue through 2024. The Muncipal Split of 1.85% Tax is increased by 13% because if our tax revenues continue to increase as history has shown, our split of those tax revenues will also increase. The Professional Consultants line has increased by 24.6% as we anticipate additional expense as we continue to work on the improvement and development arm of our mission in the Wildwoods. The Total Interest Payments on Debt has decreased by 13% per the Debt Service Schedule provided by the loan provider. Total Unrestricted Net Postion Utilized has decreased by 69.8% as we are planning for our annual revenues to cover the annual expenses with little to almost no need to utilize our reserve.

The Tourism Authority's overall revenues are sustained through the tourism economy of the Wildwoods. Over recent years, we have seen a steady increase in all tax collections. We believe that 2024 will be a strong year for tourism.

Compensation includes payments and other benefits provided to both employees and independent contractors in exchange for services.
- **Reportable Compensation** (Use the most recent W-2 available): The aggregate compensation that is reported (or required to be reported) on Form W-2, box 1 or 5, whichever amount is greater, and/or Form 1099-MISC, box 7, for the most recent calendar year ended 60 days before the start of the proposed budget year.

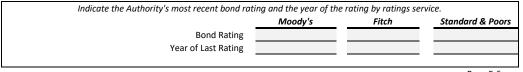
