Our 2025 budget mirrors our 2024 budget with very few significant changes:	
The 2% Tourism Tax has increased by 10.3% as we have seen tax collections continue to increase in recent years and we bel	lieve this trend
will continue for 2025. The 1.85% Tax is increased by 10.7% as we expect the increased tax revenue trend to continue in 20	25.
The Interest Earned has increased by 15.4% in anticipation of earning a higher return as our cash flow has increased	
causing our interest earned to grow.

The Tourism Authority's overall revenues are sustained through the tourism economy of the wildwoods. Over recent years, we have seen a steady increase in all tax cllections. We believe that 2025 will be a strong year for tourism.
