Parking: The Wildwoods Convention Center parking lots will be open. Inform the parking attendant that you are participating in the Flags of Liberty Ceremony, and they will waive the parking fee for the duration of the ceremony.

What to Expect...

9 am - 9:50 am

Check in at Wildwoods Convention Center - Main Lobby

Enter the main doors, and a greeter will point you to the correct check-in line for your registered veteran(s). When you check in, you'll receive a bag with the program book, ceremony site map, commemorative t-shirt, pin, and wristbands for entry to lunch. Please put on wristbands before leaving the building. Anyone needing to borrow a Flag will be directed to the "Loaner Flag Table". Anyone needing a volunteer flag holder, will be directed to the volunteer room. Please see volunteers (wearing green polo shirts or yellow vests) for assistance during the event. After check-in, please go directly to your seat in the grassy area.

10 am

Flags of Liberty Ceremony - Grassy Circle, Wildwoods Convention Center

Promptly at 10 am, the official Flags of Liberty Ceremony will commence. Honored guests, Veterans, and state dignitaries will address all invited guests and members of the public, with the Vietnam Veterans War Memorial serving as the backdrop.

Once the remarks have concluded, the procession of family and friends honoring their Veteran will take place. Participants will have an assigned "spot" (provided at check-in) for the unfurling of Flags. Participants will stretch from the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall to the Wildwoods Boardwalk.

*Spectators must remain in the grassy area until all flags are in place and unfurled.

After the Flag Ceremony, participants are invited inside the Convention Center for a light buffet. Wrist bands must be worn for entry.

ALL LOANED FLAGS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE LOANER FLAG TABLE.
